- Start Date:** Thursday, May 4, 2023
- End Date:** Thursday, August 24, 2023
- Format:** 16 week season
- May 4-11-18-25
 - June 1-8-15-22-29
 - July 13-20-27
 - August 3-10-17-24 (Position/Banquet Night)
- 2 Team Events (Optional) – July 6 (RWB) and August 31 (Tuff Night)
- Practice rounds to establish handicaps (weather permitting) – April 13-20-27
- Match play with handicaps – 24 points per match (2 per hole, 6 for total)
- Teams:** 16 teams with 5 men per team
- Fees:** \$51 league fee (prizes, range fee, and hole in one fee)
(\$31 league fee if you are a single member with golf car and range.)
\$250+tax Greens Fee (MUST BE PAID TO PLAY)
- \$128+tax league golf car
 - Must be paid for up front
 - \$10+ tax golf car fee if paid weekly
 - April practice rounds are \$15+tax each
- \$575 Twilight membership
- Covers league nights and unlimited golf after 4pm every day during the 2023 golf season
 - Must be paid for up front
- \$949 Unlimited Golf Membership
- \$1349 Unlimited Golf Membership with Golf Car and Practice Range
- Pyramids set up on the range for league nights including practice rounds
- Subs:**
1. Call the golf shop to let us know who will be subbing for you.
 2. We will fill the rosters on a first come first serve basis
- Skins:** **Optional**, Flighted and Handicapped (\$5 per week)
- Hole Events:** Flighted with \$12 credit to golf shop for the winners
- Hole-in-One:** \$1 entry fee (part of \$51 entry fee) When someone makes a hole-in-one, they win the money in the pot. All players must enter as part of league fees. If no one makes an ace this season, the money carries over to next season. Pot for this season is \$208.
- Low Net:** \$26 entry fee for the season. Top ten low net scores will compete in the low net shoot out at the end of the season. **Starts week 4**
- Low Gross:** \$30 entry fee for the season. Top ten low gross scores will compete in low Gross shoot out at end of the season. **Starts week 2**
- Banquet:** Dinner banquet compliments of Prairie Woods on final league night.
